

What changes can I expect at the Riley Park Maternity Clinic?

You will be asked screening questions at multiple times throughout your care both by phone and in person. For the safety of our staff, mothers and newborns, please answer our screening questions carefully. We have come up with creative ways to continue wholistic care, even if you are not feeling well. We are committed to providing you safe care and doing our part to decrease the spread of the virus to flatten the curve.

This means that:

- Some visits will be done by phone.
- We are asking all patients to sanitize their hands on arrival. If you are wearing gloves, you will be expected to remove them and use our hand sanitizer.
- Based on the answers to screening questions we are determining which patients need to wear a mask and use an isolation room.
- We are disinfecting surfaces multiple times a day and each isolation room is thoroughly cleaned after every patient.
- We can now draw bloodwork and collect urine samples (in most cases) when you come to the office for an appointment so that you do not have to make a separate trip to the lab.
- Support people (except for translators) and children will not be allowed in the clinic. Please wait in the car or make other arrangements.
- Parking stations are not taking cash, only credit cards.
