Summary of position

Calgary Foothills Primary Care Network (PCN) is seeking applications from individuals interested in serving as a volunteer independent member of the PCN's Board of Directors. The board is responsible for:

- input to and oversight of the strategic and business plans of the PCN;
- fostering the vision, mission and values of the organization; and,
- committing to the success and well-being of the PCN and primary care in general.

Board Members are accountable to the Chair and to each other and support the work of the PCN by fulfilling the responsibilities outlined in the Articles of Association and the Board Mandate.

Time commitment

In one year, board members can expect to attend:

- 4-6 committee meetings (two hours each) - evening
- 2 joint board meetings (three hours each) – late afternoon
- 2 joint board meetings (four to eight hours each) – daytime

Note: Meetings are held Monday through Friday; there are no weekend commitments required.

Qualifications

- systems-level experience within organizations, not necessarily in health care
- public affairs and/or government relations experience is considered an asset
- ability to contribute knowledge to the PCN Board that will help navigate the changing health care environment with stakeholders such as:
 - Government of Alberta
 - Alberta Health
 - other Calgary and provincial PCNs
 - Alberta Health Services
- can confidently assist the PCN with change management, as needed
- experience with a not-for-profit organization and/or a not-for-profit governance board is a benefit
